



## Axos – an expression of our ERGO philosophy

Nothing is more motivating for people than a good and healthy workplace. Only when people can sit in a relaxed way they can put all their energy and concentration into their work. Ergonomic seating solutions make a significant contribution to wellbeing, and also to efficiency at work. However, human beings were not designed to sit for long periods. Disorders relating to the musculoskeletal system are the number one common complaint, and the most frequent reason for incapacity

to work. There exist a huge number of suggestions as to how people should sit ergonomically. Yet even at the most ideal seating angle, tension and signs of fatigue will crop up sooner or later. This is why, together with practitioners and renowned occupational researchers such as the Fraunhofer Institut IAO, Interstuhl created its own ERGOphilosophy. This involves people being considered as a whole. ERGOphilosophy is not confined simply to the ergonomics of seating; it takes a holistic view of what needs to be provided for people to be able to work in as

healthy a way as possible. The most important conclusion from this comprehensive study is at the same time the basis of the ergonomic concept of Axos: sitting must be dynamic, and full of movement. It is only by managing to keep moving while you are sitting for long periods of time that strain on your body is effectively relieved, protecting yourself against early signs of fatigue. Axos has a great contribution to make here, because it follows the body as it moves, and supports it in every position.



The dynamic rocker mechanism ensures that Axos follows the movements of the user, and enables you to sit dynamically and actively. In doing so, Axos makes sure that an opening angle of at least 90 degrees is maintained in every sitting position.

Sprung column



When you sit down very quickly, you often experience a vertical jolt that can be very harmful to the spine and intervertebral discs. Axos makes sure by means of its seat depth spring action that a suspension is maintained, even at the lowest seat height, that effectively prevents such impacts.

Weight adjustment



When a chair follows the movements of the person sitting on it, an equilibrium between pressure and counter pressure is essential. In Axos, this equilibrium is provided by individually adjustable weight regulation. So Axos is able to carry both light and heavy users equally well.

Headrest



The first signs of tension and fatigue are often to be seen in the area of the neck muscles and shoulder muscles. Axos is able to support and protect users here too. The Axos headrest ensures that pressure in this area is reduced, giving you good support.

Take a seat and take your time. Axos lends a top-class atmosphere to rest areas and discussion sessions, a space concept for any sojourn and relaxed waiting.


